An Entry Level Course for Aspiring Project and Risk Managers

Overview: Risk Management 1A is a one-day course that provides an introduction to the processes, methodologies, terms, and skills, which are essential for Project and Risk Managers.

The concepts taught in this course are based on those found in the Project Management Institute's Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®). In addition, the course provides information, tools, and techniques in use by Project Management service providers.

The course was derived from the demand that students need a short primer that will help them apply the various Risk Management principles to their work. The presentation has been carefully created using a logical approach and understandable language. The class incorporates lecture, discussion, exercises which allow students to begin using the principles and applying them to a real world case scenario.
